Leanne Hunter is the Principal Advisor at ProErgo+. She has worked for over 20 years as a human factors and ergonomics (HFE) professional, with 8 years in the Science Division at the Health and Safety Executive in the United Kingdom. She has worked as a part-time contractor for an ergonomics consultancy and as a senior health and safety advisor for a large healthcare provider. There she gained valuable health and safety experience and completed the NEBOSH International General Certificate.

Most recently she has worked as the Principal Advisor in the Human Factors/Ergonomics team at WorkSafe specialising in musculoskeletal health risk management. She is a Certified New Zealand Human Factors and Ergonomics professional ([CNZHFE](#)) and is listed on the [HASANZ Register](#).
